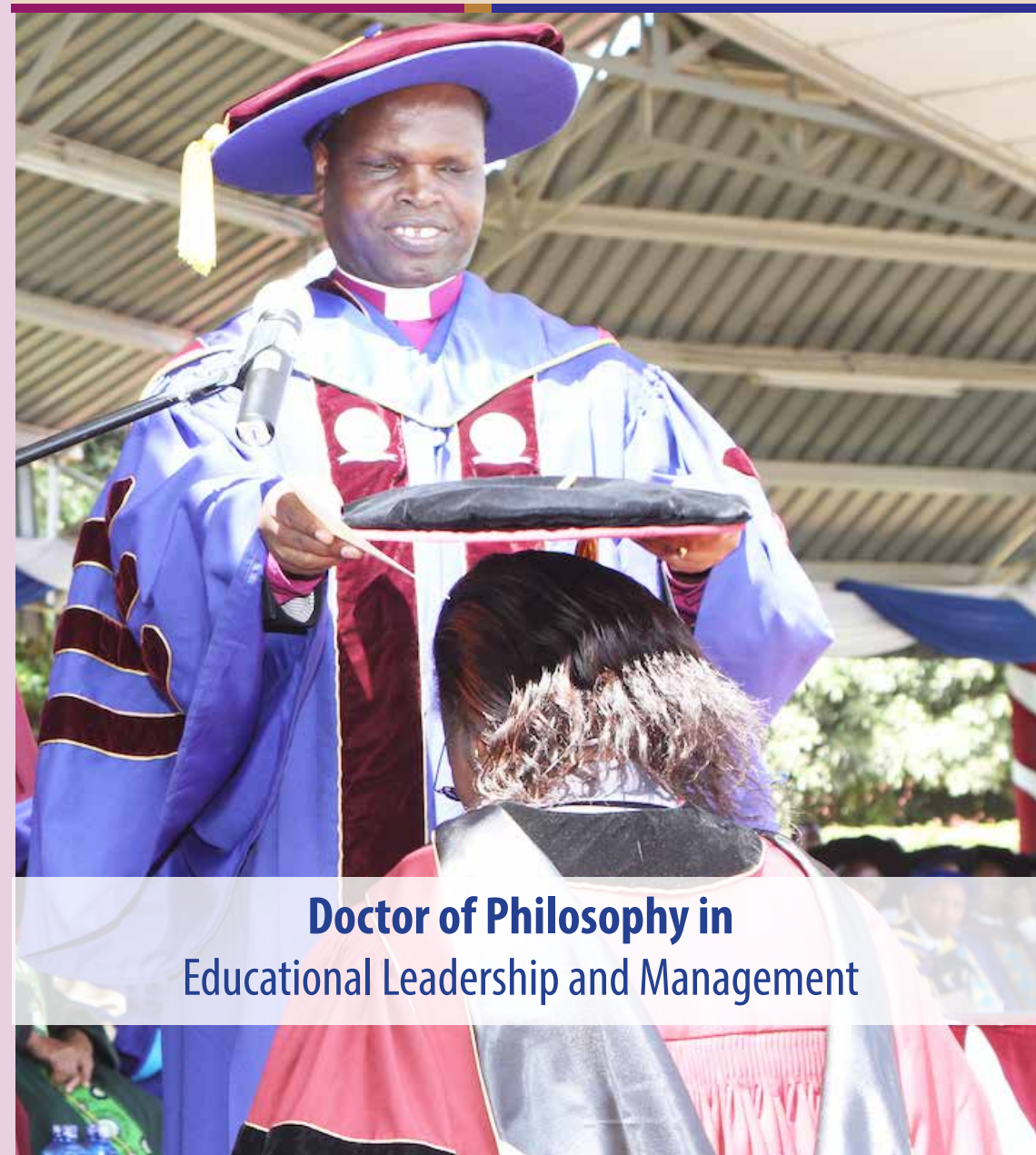

### About the program

The Doctor of Philosophy in Educational Leadership and Management programme seeks to produce informed scholars of high integrity, who have critical and practical application of knowledge to issues related to educational leadership and research.

The goal of the proposed PhD programme in Educational Leadership and Management is to develop and enhance competencies of teaching, research, and servant leadership in the field of education and prepare students for careers in academia, research and transformative educational leaders and managers needed in the 21st century.

### Expected Learning Outcomes of the Programme

By the end of the programme the learner should be able to;

1. Articulate theories on education leadership and management
2. Conduct critical analysis of research studies to determine technical adequacy and their implication for research in educational leadership.
3. Apply appropriate methodologies in research to address educational issues at the national and international levels.
4. Provide leadership in institutions of learning, international organization and government of Kenya.
5. Collaborate and consult with a network of educational leaders to support intellectual, professional and career development.

### Mode of Delivery of the Programme

The Doctor of Philosophy in Educational Leadership

and Management will be offered through coursework and thesis taken on full-time and part-time basis.

### University Admission Requirements for the PhD Programme

For admission into the programme, a candidate must satisfy all of the following requirements:

1. Be a holder of a Master's degree in Educational Leadership and Management from a recognized institution with a minimum GPA of 3.00 or its equivalent.
- or
2. An equivalent qualification approved by the Commission for University Education

### Graduation Requirements

The following requirements shall be sufficient for every student to be considered as having qualified for graduation for the Doctor of Philosophy in Educational Leadership and Management from Kenya Methodist University:-

- a. Must have successfully completed and passed thirty (30) credit hours of core courses ten (10 courses) and six (6) credit hours for electives (2 courses); a total of 36 credit hours (12 courses) for course work; six (6) credit hours for seminars and twenty four (24) credits for proposal and Thesis writing. The graduation requirement will be a total of 66 credit hours.
- b. Attained a final cumulative GPA of 3.0 after fulfilling all the requirements in (a) above.
- c. Must have completed all the requirements of the degree within five (5) years after enrolling into the programme. For extension and re- admission the candidate should apply to the Board of Post-Graduate Studies

### Duration and Structure of the Programme

The programme is designed to take a minimum of three (3) calendar years or 9 trimesters and a maximum of six calendar years or 15 trimesters. Students can take more than the minimum required courses for the programme.
