**Master of Education (M Ed.) in
Leadership and Education
Management**

About the Program

The Education sector in Kenya as well as in many other countries of the world accounts for the largest percentage of the national budgets. Kenya has many educational institutions which need to be managed professionally

Master of Education in Leadership & Management at KeMU is designed to address educational issues that need good management and leadership skills using latest strategic management styles which will make education responsive to the needs of society. The purpose of this programme is to build capacity in Leadership and Education Management in Kenya and the Eastern African Region. The programme provides a broad view of issues related to the management and leadership of education. MELM emphasises on the current philosophies and practices in management and leadership with reference to education.

Objectives of the Programme

The M. Ed. (Leadership and Education Management) programme intends among others to develop the capability of the students upon graduation to manage educational institutions and /or programmes professionally.

Specific Objectives:

- (i) Build capacity of human resources in the education sector
- (ii) Offer leadership skills.

- (iii) Provide students with knowledge and research skills to enable them to teach in tertiary institutions
- (iv) Provide a basis for advanced studies/research in Education management and leadership

Expected Competences of Graduates

In order to achieve the purpose of the programme, the graduates of this programme are expected to:-

- (i) Demonstrate understanding of theory and practice of education management and leadership
- (ii) Critically analyze and implement management policies related to education
- (iii) Demonstrate leadership in implementing policies or following educational problems
- (iv) Demonstrate ability to use evidence-based decision making for effective and efficiency Leadership in solving educational problems
- (v) Conduct research in education management and leadership problems
- (vi) Offer leadership and the management of education effectiveness
- (vii) Be a consultant in matters related to education

Target Students

The M.Ed. (Leadership and Education Management) is customized for or targets the following people:-

- (i) Those in Management positions in educational institutions in both private/Public sectors e.g. Principals, Educational entrepreneurs, Education Officials
- (ii) Those who wish to take up management positions in the Education sector e.g. teachers

- (iii) Those teachers who wish to teach Education Management and leadership in higher Institutions of learning
- (iv) Those who wish to establish consultancy and research in the Management of education

Admission Requirement for the M.Ed – Leadership and Education Management

For admission/eligibility into the above programme, a candidate must satisfy any of the following minimum requirements,

Either;

- i) Be a holder of a Bachelor of Education Degree of KeMU or from any other recognized institution with a minimum GPA of 3.00 or its equivalent or;
- (i) Be a holder of B.A or BSc. (Upper Division Honors) with a postgraduate diploma in education from a recognized institution or;
- (ii) Be a holder of B.Ed (Arts/Sciences); B.A/BSc. Lower Second Class Honors plus a postgraduate diploma in education (Lower Second Class Honors) may get provisional admission.

Note: When a candidate is given provisional admission, he/she is required to attain a minimum GPA of 2.75 during the first semester examination failure to which a student is automatically discontinued.

Credit Requirement

A minimum of 60 credit hours are required for graduation with a M.Ed. Leadership and Education Management. Programme Duration, Mode of Study, Loading and Structure.

Duration

The M. Ed. (Education Leadership & Education Management) shall extend for a minimum of eighteen (18) months and Maximum of twenty four (24) months.

Mode of Study

The candidates applying for this programme shall be required to choose one of the following modes of study:

- i) Full Time
- ii) Part Time (weekends/evenings)
- iii) School Based
- iv) Distance Learning

Course loading

A candidate may register for this degree through one of the following options:

- (i) Coursework, examination and Thesis
- (ii) Course work, examination and Project

Students registered in the second option shall take 2 extra courses in the third trimester but shall be expected to present their project report before the end of the stipulated duration of the programme.

The loading shall be as shown below:-

Option one:

Course work:

(i) 15 Courses = 45 Credits

Thesis:

(ii) Thesis (equivalent to 5 courses) = 15 credits

Total: 60 credits

Option two:

Course work:

(i) 17 Courses = 51Credits

(ii) Project (equivalent 3 courses) = 9Credits

Total: 60 credits
