This is to inform all students who have qualified for conferment of degrees and award of diplomas and certificates of Kenya Methodist University during the 2025/2026 academic year that the 26th Graduation Ceremony will be held on **Saturday, 7th November 2026** from **8.30 a.m.** at the **Graduation Square, Main Campus, Meru.**

Detailed information regarding the preparations for the ceremony is as follows:

1. Fees Clearance

All prospective graduands are advised that it is mandatory to clear their financial obligations (inclusive graduation fees) with the University and get a final clearance certificate before or by **Wednesday 30th September, 2026**. No student with a fee balance will be cleared for graduation.

2. Graduation Fees

Graduands are required to verify with the office of Registrar Academic Affairs that details pertaining to the spelling and order of their names, courses, programme of study, specialization are correct as they should appear in their certificates and final transcripts by **Wednesday 30th September, 2026**. Please note, according to the University Examination and Certification Policy names cannot be changed after graduation.

4. Academic Attire

Academic attire will be available for issue from **Monday, 26th October 2026 to Thursday 5th November, 2026** at your respective campus. The attire must be returned by **Monday 23rd November 2026** after which a fine of **KES. 500** applies per day.

5. Graduation Booklet

Official graduation e-booklet will be available for download in KeMU website on **Saturday, 7th November 2026**.

6. Rehearsal & Commissioning Service

Graduands wishing to participate in the graduation ceremony **MUST** attend the rehearsal and the commissioning service on **Friday 6th November 2026**. Graduands should be seated at **12.00 noon**. The Academic procession will start at **1.00 pm**.

7. Graduation Ceremony

All graduands participating in **26th graduation ceremony** should be seated at the Graduation Square, Main Campus, by **8.00 a.m.** on **Saturday, 7th November 2026**. Graduands **MUST** remain seated until the end of ceremony.
