The above subject matter refers.

In compliance with the Commission of University Education's requirement that all post-graduate students must publish their theses work before graduation, the office of Registrar (Academic Affairs) wishes to remind all the post-graduate students in KeMU that;

- 1) All Master students must provide an evidence of at least one publication from their research work in a peer reviewed journal before they qualify to graduate from KeMU
- 2) All Ph.D students likewise must provide an evidence of at least two publications from their research work from a peer reviewed journal before they qualify to graduate from KeMU
- 3) A turnitin anti-plagiarism report is required from these students and must be within the required levels i.e. (below 20%).
- 4) All the evidences (printed article from the journal) must be deposited with the directorate of post-graduate studies in KeMU before clearance

All postgraduate students are therefore requested to liaise with their supervisors and chairs of Departments urgently and ensure that this requirement from CUE is strictly adhered to. Students are reminded to include the names of their supervisors in the journal articles before publication.

Please note that no postgraduate student will from now henceforth be cleared for graduation in KeMU without fulfilling this requirement. You are advised to start your publication (s) early enough to avoid the last minute rush.
