- 2) All students have been registered on the online platform to facilitate Teaching & Learning

- 4) All lecturers teaching FULL-TIME and PART-TIME modes are required to immediately upload learning materials and assignments via the Virtual learning platform accessible at <https://virtual.kemu.ac.ke>
- 5) For Students, a guide to interact on the Virtual Platform - login credentials, access of lecture notes and submission of assignments, discussions, and interaction with other students have been provided on this link <https://virtual.kemu.ac.ke>
- 6) Postgraduate thesis supervision continues uninterrupted.

Students are advised to clear the outstanding fees balances in preparation for the examinations which will be administered one week after the University re-opens as per Government directives moving forward.
